ORDER

This cause comes before the Court upon the Report and Recommendation, filed by Magistrate Judge Amanda Arnold Sansone on May 10, 2017 (Doc. 4). In the Report and Recommendation, Magistrate Judge Sansone recommends that this case be dismissed, as Plaintiffs have failed to file a complaint, a renewed affidavit of indigency, or pay the filing fee.
