**ORDER STAYING LITIGATION**

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon the “Joint Status Report and Motion to Extend Stay” (doc. 15). To date, there have been no deadlines established nor a trial date set. As grounds for the request to stay proceedings, the parties state that they have scheduled a feasibility study regarding the property at issue. The information obtained as a result of this investigation will be very useful in settlement negotiations because it will assist the parties in development of a remedial action plan.

Therefore, for good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The motion to stay (doc. 15) is hereby **granted**

2. All proceedings are hereby stayed until **Wednesday, July 1, 2009.**
3. Within 30 days after Plaintiff receives the Site Assessment Report Addendum regarding the property at issue in this litigation, the parties shall file a joint status report and request that the Court schedule a status conference to discuss further proceedings.
