ORDER STAYING CONSIDERATION OF MOTION TO DISMISS

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court on the Defendants' Motion to Dismiss for lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction (doc. 16), which asserts that the Plaintiffs' case is moot. Plaintiffs have filed a memorandum in opposition to this motion (doc. 18). On April 29, 2009, fifteen days after this suit was filed, Defendant National Marine Fisheries Service promulgated an emergency rule closing the bottom longline fishery, the continued operation of which is the subject of this dispute. On or before November 13, 2009, the Parties shall notify the Court regarding the status of the authorization of the bottom
