ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S APPLICATION FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES

Before the court is the magistrate judge's report and recommendation (doc. 25) docketed July 28, 2015. any debt owed by Johnson to the United States. If the United States Department of

the Treasury determines that Johnson does not owe a federal debt, the government

may accept Johnson's assignment of EAJA fees and pay fees directly to Johnson's

counsel.
