ORDER

This cause is before the court upon plaintiff's response (doc. 15) to this court's order (doc. 10) requiring him to show cause why this civil rights action should not be dismissed for failure to comply with an order of the court, namely, the court's March 23, 2010 order (doc. 9) requiring plaintiff to either pay the filing fee or file a complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
