ORDER

This cause comes on for consideration upon the magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation dated December 27, 2016 (doc. 17). 2. Plaintiff is hereby awarded attorney's fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act in the amount of \$3,566.55, to be paid by defendant Commissioner within a reasonable time of this order.

3. The Commissioner shall follow *Astrue v. Ratliff*, but make prompt payment of the amount due, as no showing of an outstanding federal debt has been made to date.
