ORDER

This cause comes on for consideration upon the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation dated May 10, 2017. ECF No. 28. The parties have been furnished a copy of the Report and Recommendation and have been afforded an opportunity to file objections pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 636(b)(1). 4. The Clerk is directed to close the file.
5. A certificate of appealability is **DENIED**.
