**ORDER**

The magistrate judge issued a Report and Recommendation on August 27, 2024 (ECF No. 10), recommending that Plaintiff's case be dismissed without prejudice as malicious under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(i) for his abuse of the judicial process. The parties were furnished a copy of the Report and Recommendation and afforded an opportunity to file objections pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 636(b)(1).
