IT IS ORDERED:

The report and recommendation is **accepted and adopted** over Plaintiff's objections as this Court's opinion. The motion to dismiss, ECF No. 24 is **GRANTED** as to all claims and all Defendants with the exception of Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment claim against Defendant Beem and Eighth Amendment claim against Defendant Beem and Eighth Amendment claim against Defendant Hawkins; that the claims proceed against the Defendants in their individual capacities only; that Plaintiff's request for declaratory and injunctive relief be stricken as moot due to his transfer; and that the request for damages be

limited to nominal damages pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1997(e). This case is

REMANDED to the Magistrate for further proceedings on the two surviving claims.
