ORDER ADOPTING THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S  
SECOND REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

Before the court is the magistrate judge's second report and recommendation (doc. 61) docketed March 16, 2017. The magistrate judge recommends that Dr. Leonard Schlofman's motion to dismiss be granted. All other defendants were previously dismissed by order (doc. 60) entered March 3, 2017.
