ORDER ADOPTING THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S  
REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

Before the court is the magistrate judge's report and recommendation (doc. 26) docketed October 4, 2017. The magistrate judge recommends that the plaintiff's case be dismissed for failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2). 4. The clerk shall note on the docket that this cause was dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii).
