ORDER ACCEPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This Court has considered, without hearing, the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation, ECF No. 19, and has also reviewed *de novo* Plaintiff's objections, ECF No. 20. Oct. 7, 2013) (dismissing similar claims challenging TRULINCS restriction and listing cases where other courts reached the same conclusion).
