## ORDER

Attorney for this District by regular mail or by hand delivery. All costs of service

shall be advanced by the United States.

4. After a response to the complaint has been filed by the defendant, the

plaintiff shall be required to mail to the attorney for the defendant a copy of every

pleading or other paper, including letters, submitted for consideration by the court.

The plaintiff shall include with the original paper to be filed with the clerk of court

a certificate stating the date a correct copy of the paper was mailed to each

defendant or to the attorney representing each defendant. Any paper submitted for

filing after a response to the complaint has been filed by the defendant which does

not contain a certificate of service shall be returned by the clerk and disregarded by

the court.
