## **ORDER**

This matter was heard on Friday, September 23, 2011. The Respondent appeared *Pro Se* and requested that she be allowed additional time up to and including Friday, October 28, 2011, in which to produce the documents identified in the government's tax summons. Should the Respondent fail to comply, this Court will act as necessary, including the scheduling of any necessary contempt hearing.
