ORDER ADOPTING THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

Before the court is the magistrate judge's report and recommendation docketed November 12, 2013. <u>See</u> Doc. 13. The magistrate judge recommends that the plaintiff's claims against Nobles, Hayes, Brown, Mason, McDowell, Davis, and Bowen be dismissed for failure to state a claim.
