ORDER

This cause comes on for consideration upon the chief magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation dated October 6, 2015 (doc. 23). The parties have been furnished a copy of the Report and Recommendation and have been afforded an opportunity to file objections pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 636(b)(1). No objections have been filed.

Having considered the Report and Recommendation, I have determined that the Report and Recommendation should be adopted.

Accordingly, it is now **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The chief magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation is adopted and incorporated by reference in this order.
2. Plaintiff shall recover fees in the amount of \$2,966.72, for time expended by his counsel in representing him before the United States District Court for the Northern District of Florida pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2412 (EAJA). The fee award is subject to an offset to satisfy any qualifying outstanding debt that Plaintiff may owe to the United States.
