<u>ORDER</u>

This cause comes on for consideration upon the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation dated February 21, 2024, ECF No. 86. accordance with this Order and the Order dated August 9, 2022, ECF No. 31. The

judgment shall state: "Plaintiff's individual and official-capacity claims against

Defendant Everett, Defendant Roger, Defendant Jodom and Defendant Centurion

are **DISMISSED** with prejudice under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b), for failure to state a

claim upon which relief can be granted. Plaintiff's official-capacity claim against

Defendant Scoggins is **DISMISSED** with prejudice under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b) for

failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted. Plaintiff's individual-

capacity claim against Defendant Scoggins is **DISMISSED** for failure to exhaust

administrative remedies as required by 42 U.S.C. § 1997e(a).

5. The clerk of court will close this case file.
