1. The above-styled cause be and the same is hereby **DISMISSED** 

without prejudice pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m)

for Plaintiff's failure to serve Defendants and for Plaintiff's

failure to abide by the terms and conditions of the Court's prior

Order (DE 8); and

2. To the extent not otherwise disposed of herein, all pending

motions are hereby **DENIED** as moot.
