Dear Mr. Marvin:

U. S. District Judge Adalberto Jordan, Southern District of Florida, yesterday entered an Order in which he states that certain material which Florida Bar-licensed attorney Norm Kent is offering through his web sites, to anyone of any age, with no age verification and free of charge, is “obscene.”

I am sure that this excellent federal judge knows what the word “obscene” means, in light of the constitutional definition of it in *Miller v. California* and as embodied in Florida’s *criminal code*.

Therefore, now that a respected federal judge has deemed “obscene” the material Mr. Kent is offering by linking to his porn portal from his Bar-regulated law firm site, please proceed against Mr. Kent, as previously requested. This is a terrific development.

This court’s Order makes The Bar’s action against Mr. Kent mandatory and inescapable.

Please proceed. The Bar has procrastinated on this for months.
