Dear Mr. Marvin:

Attached please find a letter signed by Florida attorney Alvin Entin which labels me an "obscenity trafficker." This is after his client was caught distributing what Judge Jordan called "obscenity" to anyone of any age through the Internet. Mr. Kent even understands what that finding meant, as he removed it from his porn portal site in a panic, having been caught, with The Bar having done absolutely nothing about it for months.

If The Bar is going to insist upon enforcing Florida Bar Rule 4-8.4 (d) in such a way, as it has against me, to prohibit "disparagement" of others, then The Bar has no choice but to proceed against Mr. Entin for sending me the attached letter. He is, of course, Mr. Kent's lawyer in a libel action against me, so this is disparagement of an opposing party in the context of litigation.

I am not sure how one libels someone who *really* is an "obscenity" trafficker, but we shall see.

What's good for the goose is good for the gander, Mr. Marvin. If The Bar is going to have its "speech codes," then it is going to have to enforce them against *everyone*. If you do that, there will be more Bar employees than lawyers. The Bar should have thought of that.
