**PLAINTIFF'S NOTICE TO COURT IN LIGHT OF HEARING NEXT WEEK**

COMES NOW plaintiff, John B. Thompson, as an attorney on his own behalf, and provides notice to the court in light of its recent show cause order and in light of the hearing on October 9 thereon:

Norm Kent is distributing to anyone of any age material that, this court found to be "obscenity." That is a criminal act.


He is now publicly threatening the undersigned for having written law enforcement officials and informed them of this activity. The attached threat by Kent constitutes extortion, in violation of state and federal law.

Thompson respectfully requests that this court do what it should have done days ago: Alert U.S. Attorney Alex Acosta, since he is in this court's jurisdiction, to proceed against both this obscenity and this extortion.

Mr. Kent is attempting extort a party before you and to influence this litigation. You have an obligation, I believe, especially in light of the fact that it was this court that improperly sought to discipline Thompson for bringing evidence of this criminal activity

to you, to do what this court should and must do to see that federal laws, pertaining to obscenity and extortion, are enforced.
