Judge Denies Thompson's Motion to Leave Case

Coral Gables Lawyer Referred for Possible Disciplinary Action

Jack Thompson tried today to amend his complaint against the Florida Bar today by naming Judge Jordan as a defendant, personally. But he has other problems first. The Court has rebuked his attempts to dismiss the proposed disciplinary committee he was referred to, and denied a motion to recuse himself from the case.

Legal experts scoffed at Thompson's new motions as the "machinations of a desperate man."

The case is set for final hearing next Monday in Miami, and this afternoon U S District Judge Adalberto Jordan made it blistering clear he will be the sitting jurist to hear the final arguments.

All of Thompson's efforts to dismiss him have been denied, and he responded with yet another motion today repeatedly and personally attacking as a "liar" the respected Barry Richard, who represents the Florida Bar. Barry Richard, you may recall, is the lawyer who represented President Bush in the 2000 presidential recount vote.

In his opinion this afternoon, Judge Jordan summarized the fractured logic Thompson was using in this case, accusing the Bar of discriminating against him at every turn.

Stated the Court, directly to Thompson: "Thompson unfortunately appears to believe that every act taken against him, and any judicial ruling adverse to him, are part of a vast conspiracy designed to silence him and destroy him."

Additionally the court wrote that "Mr. Thompson's threat of a lawsuit is insufficient for me to recuse myself...if a judge were required to recuse whenever a litigant threatened to sue him, disgruntled parties would be able to forum shop" anywhere or anytime.

Then the Court sent the following advisory to Thompson, accused of filing in the court record three pornographic images of gay men involved in graphic sexual acts "just because Mr. Thompson believes he did nothing wrong ... does not mean I have to agree with him.....", the jurist wrote.

The images Thompson posted, NGN has now learned, were in the body of a letter he attached in an exhibit, which the court has now sealed from public view. It was filing that document so openly for anyone in the court system or the public to access which caught the judge's ire, and caused him to refer Thompson's action to a disciplinary committee for possible sanctions. The court will await their review before making any determinations.

The letter was directed to the Governor of the State of Florida, and the Attorney General, along with the United States Attorney and Broward County State Attorney. The content of Thompson's letter was that Norm Kent, the NGN Publisher, was trafficking in obscenity because his law firm, at www.normkent.com, has a link

to www.nationalgaynews.com, which has a link to Adult Sites, which has a link to other sites, which open up links to more sites, which have allegedly pornographic material on them. As stated in the Adult Links portals, NGN has no control over the content of the publishers. It is offered as a service to our readers, who may or may not elect to visit or join those sites," stated Dennis Josephwicz, the NGN webmaster.

Stated Kent, "The bottom line in all this is that Jack, to use his own phrase, was too clever for his own good, and it is coming back to bite him in the arse'. He deserves what he gets and he is going to get what he deserves."
















Kent concluded, "I do not take lightly his writing to the chief law enforcement officers of this state accusing me of criminal behavior. Apart from any discipline meted out against him, I may very well file yet another Libel action against him for defamation and slander. He paid me \$50,000 once before for this recklessness. Looks like he wants to double the ante."

Re: Ft. Lauderdale Attorney Norm Kent and His Dissemination of "Obscenity"

Dear Mr. Satz:

Recently U.S. District Court Judge Adalberto Jordan issued an order in which he found that certain material being distributed by Ft. Lauderdale Norm Kent, which I provided the court, is "obscenity." Mr. Kent is doing this by computer with no age verification as to its recipients. Take a look at www.justusboys.com to see if you agree with Judge Jordan as to his statement that this is "obscenity." I don't doubt that you will agree with him.

Kent is doing this, if you can believe it, by linking his official, Bar-regulated law firm web site to www.nationalgaynews.com, which serves as a porn portal to sites like www.justusboys.com.

As I read the state's obscenity law, Mr. Kent may be violating a number of criminal provisions therein. One of the users of the www.justusboys.com site describes it as one which is surely being used by pedophiles.

Mr. Kent has may have also committed the act of extortion, as Kent is stating at his porn portal site, quoting himself, that he is going to punish me for reporting the distribution of what Judge Jordan calls "obscenity" ***to law enforcement officials***. I believe that very public threat constitutes extortion under Florida law, as Mr. Kent is attempting to intimidate me for the exercise of my First Amendment right to "petition the government for a redress of grievances." Only an ACLU hypocrite would suggest that writing one's government officials about the distribution of what a federal judge has branded "obscenity" is not protected by the First Amendment but that the distribution of this filth to anyone of any age is protected by the First Amendment.

I am ready to appear before a grand jury on all of this, including the threats that Mr. Kent has repeatedly made against me to have me arrested, etc.

If your office does not proceed as to the "obscenity," given that Florida Statute 847.011 (9) states that "The several sheriffs and state attorneys shall vigorously enforce" the

obscenity laws, then a writ of mandamus is appropriately issued against you, since “shall” is the strongest command verb in the English language.
