Dear Mr. Marvin:

Because there is such a thing as redemption, I want to afford you and The Bar one more chance to begin to undo its denial of equal protection, compounded and worsened by its protection of The Bar's active shielding of my SLAPP Bar complainants from the consequences of their own unethical actions.
