**SUPPLEMENT TO

STATE DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

COMES NOW petitioner, John B. Thompson, (Thompson) an attorney on his own behalf, and files this supplement to his petition for a writ of prohibition and/or a writ of mandamus, and an emergency stay of the lower court proceedings as well as the state bar disciplinary proceedings, stating:

The Florida Bar has now been found to be actively engaged in tampering with a witness because he has come forward to corroborate petitioner's allegations about the misconduct of The Florida Bar. The Bar's attempt to intimidate this witness can be proven. When this criminal witness tampering first surfaced, the judge in the trial court below, Judge Adalberto Jose Jordan, refused to address this disturbing development. In the last twenty-four hours The Bar criminal conduct in this regard has both deepened and become more obvious. Thus, we have in the trial court below a U.S. District Court Judge who has become so intent upon harming Thompson that he refuses to protect the very integrity of the judicial process.
