

SUBJECT OF VOTE ALLEGATIONS:

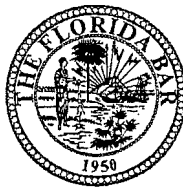
The conduct under investigation concerns your client's conduct in relation to the case of *John B. Thompson on behalf of the State of Florida v. Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. et. al.* Case No. 06-16311 CA 02. This case was assigned to Judge Ronald Friedman. Your client made statements about Judge Friedman, which he knew to be false or with a reckless disregard as to its truth concerning the qualifications or integrity of Judge Friedman, made misrepresentations about Judge Friedman and knowingly or through callous indifference, made statements about Judge Friedman to disparage or humiliate him and attempt to intimidate him. Your client also made statements that had no substantial purpose other than to embarrass Judge Friedman.

Further under investigation is your client's failure to respond to the bar's inquiries in this matter.


Dear Mr. Reiser:
