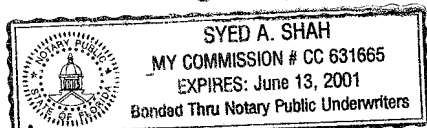


significant interest. Therefore, the choice of law rule does not insulate an attorney from the disciplinary rules of his licensing state. Accordingly, under Rule 3-4.6(b), the Florida Bar, may invoke its own disciplinary rules which are consistent with the rules imposed by the Alabama Bar.

16. In examining the Florida Bar's complaint, the Florida Bar has identified in Count I, paragraph 16, Count II, paragraph 41, and Count III, paragraph 61, the local ethical rules which parallel Alabama's rules. Therefore, portions of the complaint that cite violations of the Florida Bar rules for conduct occurring in Alabama will not be dismissed.

WHEREUPON, it is **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that:

1. The Motion to Dismiss the Alabama Bar Complaints on the Basis of Lack of Jurisdiction and Fraud and Prosecutorial Misconduct is hereby **DENIED**; and
2. The Motion and Memorandum in Support of His Motion to Dismiss Those Portions of the Complaint Relying Upon Alleged Violations of Florida Bar Rules, is hereby **DENIED**.
