**NOTICE TO COURT**

COMES NOW plaintiff, John B. Thompson, hereinafter Thompson, as an attorney on his own behalf, and provides notice to this court as follows:

1. Court's law clerk kindly contacted the parties yesterday and indicated that the court was intending to convene a hearing on plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction. She wanted to know when the trial of Thompson in the "disciplinary" matter would be, and Thompson said the first week of September.
