
**ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS OF MAGISTRATE JUDGE
AND DISMISSING CASE WITH PREJUDICE**

THIS MATTER is before the Court upon the Order Approving Settlement Agreement [DE 32] entered by Magistrate Judge O'Sullivan. On August 17, 2009, Magistrate Judge O'Sullivan conducted a fairness hearing on the parties' settlement of this Fair Labor Standards Action and determined that the compromise reached by the parties, including the resolution of costs and attorneys' fees, was a "fair and reasonable" outcome of the parties' bona fide disputes under *Lynn's Food Stores, Inc. v. United States*, 679 F.2d 1350 (11th Cir. 1982). Therefore, upon review, it is hereby

ORDERED that

- (1) Magistrate Judge O'Sullivan's findings are ADOPTED.
- (2) All pending motions not otherwise ruled upon are DENIED AS MOOT.
- (3) This case is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE and this case is CLOSED.
