THIS CAUSE is before the Court upon Magistrate Judge Patrick A. White's Report of Magistrate Judge [DE 7] ("Report"), filed August 4, 2009, recommending dismissal of Plaintiff's civil rights complaint. Plaintiff is proceeding *in forma pauperis*, and upon initial screening under 28 U.S.C. § 1915, Magistrate Judge White concluded that Plaintiff has failed to state a claim.
