PER CURIAM:

We consider whether the district court correctly granted summary judgment to the Hertz Corporation ("Hertz"). We review the district court's decisions de novo. *Mize v. Jefferson City Bd. of Educ.*, 93 F.3d 739, 742 (11th Cir. 1996).

After a careful review of the parties' briefs and the record, we find that the district court's well-reasoned opinion accurately resolved the issues in this case. For the reasons stated by the district court in its September 16, 2003 Order, we find that the Teamsters Local Union 390 did not act with reckless disregard for Nelson Beaubrun's rights nor was it grossly deficient in its conduct. Thus, Hertz was entitled to summary judgment. Accordingly, the grant of summary judgment to Hertz is AFFIRMED.

AFFIRMED.
