ORDER REQUIRING RESPONSE

This matter is before the Court on Defendants South Florida Council Inc., Boy Scouts of America, and Boy Scouts of America's Appeal of the Order Following Discovery Conference in Part ("Appeal") [ECF No. 97] and Defendants Howard K. Crompton and Andrew L. Schmidt's Notice of Joinder in Defendants South Florida Council Inc., Boy Scouts of America, and Boy Scouts of America's Appeal ("Notice") [ECF No. 98].

On December 29, 2010, U.S. Magistrate Judge Chris M. McAliley issued an Order Following Discovery Conference requiring, *inter alia*, the parties to file a joint discovery plan specifically itemizing outstanding discovery and a schedule for completing such discovery. [ECF No. 80]. Defendants' appeal states that "Defendants only object to one sentence of the Order [and] only seek[] to set aside the sentence, 'Thus, each person to be deposed shall be named, along with a date for their deposition.'" [ECF No. 97] (citing [ECF No. 80 at ¶ 3]). Plaintiffs have not yet filed a response to the Appeal or Notice. Having reviewed the Appeal, Notice, the record, and being otherwise duly advised, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. Plaintiffs shall file a response to Defendants' Appeal and Notice **no later than Wednesday, January 19, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.**
2. The parties shall comply with all requirements set forth in the Order Following Discovery Conference [ECF No. 80], including but not limited to filing a joint discovery plan no later than **Friday, January 14, 2011**, as required in the December 29, 2010 Order. To the extent possible, the parties shall list individuals who they agree shall be deposed with dates for their depositions.
