cannot be postponed without severe prejudice.

3. The hearing scheduled by the Court in this matter is an important one and

accordingly, it is necessary for undersigned counsel to be in attendance. Moreover, the only other

attorney in undersigned counsel's firm who could even conceivably be in a position to handle this

matter is scheduled to be in Orlando in connection with the hearing with another matter on Thursday.

4. Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for the Defendants, Boy Scouts of

America, South Florida Council and Plantation United Methodist Church and they have no objection

to the rescheduling of this hearing for either Friday, February 11 in the afternoon or Monday

February 14 in the morning, if either time is agreeable to the Court. Undersigned counsel has not

received a response at this time to his request from the Defendants Crompton and Schmidt.
