- 3. Defendant Crompton shall provide a complete list of witnesses in response to interrogatory 6. If no additional witnesses are known to the defendant, he shall provide a supplemental response which so indicates.
 - 4. Defendant Crompton shall produce documents in response to Plaintiffs' request 1.

- 5. To the extent additional documents exist in response to requests 2, 8, and 13-15, those shall likewise be produced or made available for inspection at a mutually convenient time and place.
- 6. Defendant Crompton shall respond to Plaintiffs' Requests for Admissions 9 and 10 by either admitting or denying the request.
- 7. All discovery ordered herein shall be provided to the Plaintiffs no later than 5 working days from the date of this Order.
