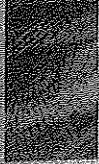

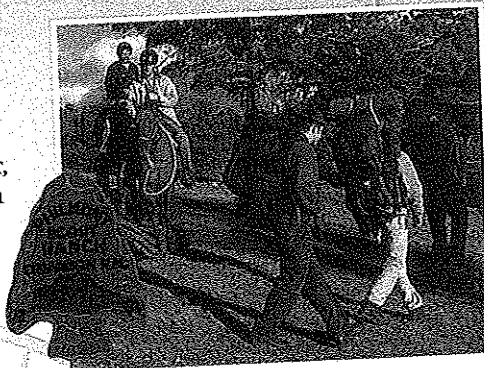
trek adventures the *Fieldbook* describes. For others, the information in the pages of the *Fieldbook* is the promise of what lies ahead in Scouting.
