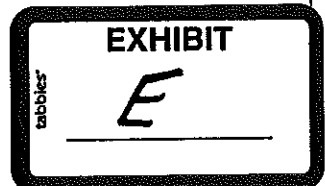

1. My name is David Rourke.

3. In November of 2010, the cellular telephone I had been given by Park Row Printing started to break down. The buttons stopped working. I went to the Owner and President, George Crompton, and explained the problems with the cellular phone.

4. On November 30, 2010, George Crompton gave me a Blackberry Storm, which was not activated at that time, and was not being used at that time.

5. On November 30, 2010, I called Verizon Wireless from a land line at Park Row Printing, and activated the Blackberry Storm to be used with my existing phone number.

6. The person from Verizon Wireless who I spoke to, activated the Blackberry Storm. I then turned it on, it came to the main screen, and it worked.


7. I connected the Blackberry Storm to my computer and added my contacts that I had saved from my old cellular phone. Then, I began using the Blackberry Storm for business purposes and personal purposes.

8. On January 27, 2011, I went with George Crompton to the Verizon Wireless store located at 6989 W. Broward Boulevard, Plantation, FL, 33317. George Crompton bought a new Blackberry Bold 9650 for me to use, and the store transferred the contact information in the Blackberry Storm to the new Blackberry Bold 9650. George Crompton told the store employee to preserve the Blackberry Storm and not to remove any information from it. The Blackberry Storm was deactivated by the store employee. I left the store with the new Blackberry Bold 9650 and George Crompton took the Blackberry Storm.


10. I have not used or been in possession of the Blackberry Storm since January 27, 2011.

11. At no time did I ever have a password for the Blackberry Storm or use a password for the Blackberry Storm. To the best of my knowledge there is no password for the Blackberry Storm.
