**ORDER GRANTING PARTIES JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND PRE-TRIAL AND
TRIAL DEADLINES AND SETTING FORTH NEW DEADLINES**

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard before the Court upon the Joint Motion of the Parties to extend Pre-Trial and Trial Deadlines, respective counsel for the parties having agreed hereto and the Court being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is hereby;

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Joint Motion to Extend Pretrial and the Trial Deadlines [D.E. 229] filed by the Parties on June 15, 2011, is hereby GRANTED and the following deadlines set forth in this Court's order of August 30, 2010 are modified as follows:

DATE	ACTION
By: August 31, 2011	All non-expert discovery shall be completed.
By: September 15, 2011	The parties shall comply with S.D. Fla.L.R. 16.1 K concerning the exchange of expert witness summaries and reports.
By: October 7, 2011	Rebuttal expert reports shall be filed.

By: November 18, 2011	All expert discovery shall be completed.
By: November 30, 2011	Mediation shall be completed. The parties have already agreed on a mediator.
By: December 19, 2011	All dispositive pre-trial motions and memoranda of law shall be filed. See amended instructions on summary judgment briefs attached to the Court's original order. Failure to comply with these instructions may result in dismissals for summary judgment without prejudice to re-file in accordance with local rules and the instructions attached to the original order. If any party moves to strike an expert affidavit filed in support of a motion for summary judgment [for reasons stated in <i>Daubert v. Merrell Dow Pharmaceuticals, Inc.</i> , 509 U.S. 579, 125 F.D. 2d 469, 113 S.Ct. 2786 (1993) and <i>Kumho Tire Co., Ltd. v. Carmichael</i> U.S. ____ 119 S.Ct. 1167, 143 L.ed. 2d 238 (1999)[the motion to strike shall be filed without parties responsive memorandum].
By: January 13, 2012	Pre-trial stipulation and Motions in Limine. The Joint Pre-trial Stipulation shall be filed pursuant to S.D. Fla. L.R. 16.1 E in conjunction with the Joint Pre-trial Stipulation. The parties shall file their Motions in Limine.
By: February 17, 2012	The Pre-Trial Conference shall be conducted
By: March 7, 2012	Calendar call will be held at 1:30 p.m.
By: March 12, 2012	Trial is set for the two week trial period commencing March 12, 2012.
