THE SOUTH FLORIDA COUNCIL'S
AMENDED ANSWERS TO THIRD SET OF INTERROGATORIES

Defendant, South Florida Council, Inc, Boy Scouts of America ("South Florida Council")
files this, its Amended Answers to Plaintiffs' Third set of Interrogatories:

1. Identify the specific courses and/or training programs required for an adult leader to be considered a "trained leader" entitled to wear the official Boy Scouts of America "trained" emblem, which were in effect on May 9, 2009.

Answer: The current requirements to wear the "trained" patch include completing Fast Start Training, Youth Protection Training, This is Scouting and Position Specific Training. These are Basic Training courses. SFC believes that the requirements in 2009 were the same save for the requirement beginning in 2010 of the Youth Protection Training.



2. Identify, which, if any of the above courses and/or programs had been completed by Howard Crompton as of May 9, 2009.

Answer:

According to the information SFC has in its possession: Youth Protection Training, Fast Start Training, New Leader Essentials (now called This is Scouting) and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills. However, SFC can only process training records if paperwork is turned in by the adult leader. SFC has no way of knowing whether Howard Crompton has completed any other courses and/or programs for which he did not turn in paperwork indicating his completion. A prerequisite to completing Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills is Position Specific Training. Therefore, SFC assumes that Mr. Crompton completed Position Specific Training.

3. State whether or not Howard Crompton was a "trained leader" as that term was defined by the boy Scouts of America on May 9, 2009 and whether he was "eligible" to receive the official "trained" emblem on said date.

Answer: Based on the courses completed by Howard Crompton, SFC believes that he qualified to wear the "trained" patch.
