**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS', HOWARD K. CROMPTON AND  
ANDREW L. SCHMIDT, MOTION TO PRESERVE MATERIAL EVIDENCE AS  
TO MICHAEL ADELMAN'S AND HIS FAMILY'S COMPUTERS**

**THIS CAUSE** is before the Court on Defendants', HOWARD K. CROMPTON  
and ANDREW L. SCHMIDT, Motion to Preserve Material Evidence as to Michael  
Adelman's and his Family's Computers, and the Court having reviewed the Motion and  
being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED**  
that Defendants' Motion is **GRANTED**, as follows:

1. Plaintiffs shall disclose and preserve any and all computers on which  
Michael Adelman, Howard Adelman (Michael's father), Judith Sclawy-Adelman  
(Michael's mother), and/or Elisabeth Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's sister), accessed, sent,  
and/or received e-mails directed to Michael's troop (Troop 111).

2. For each computer on which Michael Adelman, Howard Adelman (Michael's father), Judith Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's mother), and/or Elisabeth Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's sister), accessed, sent, and/or received e-mails directed to Michael's troop (Troop 111), Plaintiffs shall describe the computer and give its current location, dates of existence and all persons who have had custody and/or use of it.

3. Plaintiffs shall disclose and preserve all e-mail accounts that Michael Adelman, Howard Adelman (Michael's father), Judith Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's mother), and/or Elisabeth Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's sister) utilized to access e-mails received from Troop 111, to forward e-mails received from Troop 111, to reply to e-mails received from Troop 111, to send e-mails to members of Troop 111, and/or to access internet information regarding Troop 111 activities (including, but not limited to the subject hike), in original and unmodified condition.

4. Plaintiffs shall disclose and preserve any documents, items, and tangible things, that show that Michael Adelman, Howard Adelman (Michael's father), Judith Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's mother), and/or Elisabeth Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's sister), accessed, sent, and/or received e-mails regarding Troop 111 activities, and/or accessed internet information regarding Troop 111 (including, but not limited to the subject hike).

5. No destructive or non-destructive testing for any computer on which Michael Adelman, Howard Adelman (Michael's father), Judith Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's mother), and/or Elisabeth Sclawy-Adelman (Michael's sister), accessed, sent,

and/or received e-mails directed to Michael's troop (Troop 111) shall be permitted unless written protocol for testing is agreed upon by all counsel.
