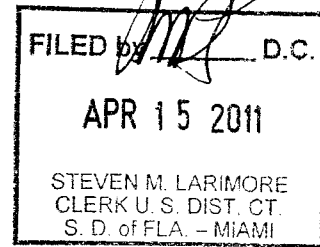

I may have a loan through Chase or a Chase Subsidiary that was extended for my education.

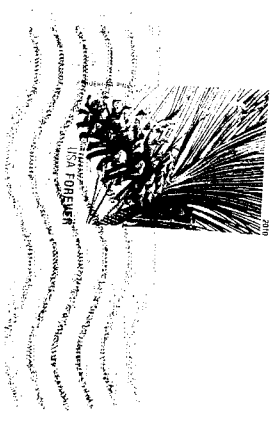
