**DECLARATION OF ANDREW SOUKUP**

Andrew Soukup hereby declares as follows:

1. I am an attorney with Covington & Burling LLP, counsel for JPMorgan Chase & Co. and Chase Bank USA, N.A. (collectively, "Chase"). I am a member of the bars of Illinois and the District of Columbia. I submit this declaration to show Chase's compliance with the notice requirements of the Class Action Fairness Act of 2005, 28 U.S.C. § 1715.

2. A copy of the settlement agreement between Plaintiffs and Chase ("Settlement") was filed with the Court on December 21, 2010. That same day, Plaintiffs and Chase filed a joint motion for preliminary approval of the settlement.


3. Between December 28, 2010 and December 30, 2010, I caused notice of the proposed Settlement ("the CAFA Notice") to be served via first-class mail on:

- the Attorney General of the United States;
- the Director for Litigation in the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency;
- the National Bank Examiner in the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency;
- the General Counsel of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System;
- the General Counsel of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York;
- the Attorneys General of all fifty States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, American Samoa, and Guam.

4. Attached as Exhibit A to this Declaration is a true and correct copy of the cover letter to the CAFA Notice that was addressed and mailed to the Attorney General of the United States. The cover letter describes the documents and information enclosed with the various CAFA Notices, which are not attached to this Declaration but are available upon request. Identical cover letters and enclosures were sent to each of the federal and state officials described in the preceding paragraph.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
