## ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR BOND

This cause is before the Court on the Plaintiffs' Motion to Direct Objectors to Post Appeal Bond. Plaintiffs ask this Court to require the Appellants/Objectors to post a bond in the total amount of \$35,000 to cover "a portion of the anticipated costs and attorneys' fees to be incurred" in connection with the appeals filed as to this Court's Final Judgment and Order of Dismissal, entered September 16, 2011. According to Fed. R. App. P. 7, the Court may require an appellant to file a bond in an amount necessary to ensure payment of costs on appeal.

Nine separate appeals have been filed, including six appeals filed by individuals appearing without counsel of record: Trevor Grant, Steven Miller, Carla Victoria Diaz, Margaret E. Wheeler, Clarke Hampe, and Katie Sibley. Three of the nine appeals were filed by counsel, on behalf of appellants Tom Blanchard and September Katje, Laura Fortman, Douglas Paluczak, and Chris Schulte, and William H. McWhorter. Having

• considered the motion, the Court does not find that a bond is necessary in this case.
