1. Reexamination of <u>claims 1-3, 5-6, and 11</u> of USP 6,101,531 (5 31 patent") has been ordered.

Reasons for Confirming Claims as Patentable

4. <u>Claims 1-3, 5-6, and 11</u> are confirmed as patentable over the prior art of record in this proceeding.

5. The '531 patent is a system which includes a <u>communications server</u> for establishing and maintaining a virtual session, via a <u>session-less</u> communication path with a <u>client communications unit</u> on the one hand and a <u>session-oriented</u> communications path with a <u>host server</u> on the other hand. (<u>col. 2:55-67 to col. 3:1-13</u>) The <u>communications server</u> and the <u>client communications unit</u> are coupled via a tariffed network or connection. (<u>Id.</u>) However, the virtual session, via a session-less oriented communication protocol between the <u>communications server</u> and the <u>client</u> <u>communications unit</u>, permits remote access to the <u>host server</u> without the expense of a circuit switched connection on the tariffed network. (<u>Id.</u>)

Pepe discloses a method of communicating data units over a network (<u>fig. 1</u>) between a <u>client communications unit</u> (#30) and a <u>host device</u> (OFFICE) via a <u>communications server</u> (#40). However, this method does not communicate data units over a wireless network because the network of **Pepe** is a wireline network (#29) Control Number: 90/010,891 Art Unit: 3992

between the *communication server* (#30) and the *host server* (OFFICE) and wireless

(#39) between the <u>client communications unit</u> (#30) and the <u>communications server</u>

(#40). As such, claims 1-3, 5-6, and 11 are confirmed as patentable over Pepe

because Pepe does not disclose or suggest a method of communicating data units over

a wireless network between a client communications unit and a host device via a

communications server in combination with the other features set forth in the claims.
