Dear Magistrate Goodman,

We are the attorneys for Mystic Mountain Limited in the above referenced matter. At the hearing on Plaintiff's Motion to Compel Better Responses to Discovery on Monday, April 23, 2012, Your Honor instructed that within ten (10) days we provide the Court a brief report indicating the number of incident reports in Mystic's possession documenting incidents were injuries were reported in connection with the subject bobsled ride, regardless of the alleged cause.

Following an investigation, Mystic determined there are twenty five (25) such incidents reported from the beginning of the bobsled operations in 2008 until the date of Plaintiff's alleged incident in June 21, 2010. Out of abundance of caution, in determining the amount, we included reports regardless of severity of the complaint (i.e. reports of temporary pain, muscle spasm, etc.)
