
ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

THE MATTER was referred to the Honorable Jacqueline Becerra, United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to 28 U.S.C § 636 for a ruling on any and all post-judgment matters, including the Motion to Vacate or, in the Alternative, Set Aside Default Judgment of Permanent Injunction, ("Motion"). (ECF No. 22.)
