ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This matter is before the Court upon the Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment [DE 24] which was previously referred to the Honorable Shaniek M. Maynard for a Report and Recommendation on any dispositive matters. On July 19, 2021, Judge Maynard issued a Report and Recommendation recommending that the Plaintiff's Motion be denied. The Plaintiff filed objections.
