

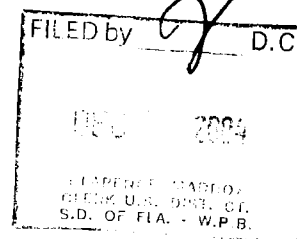

**& ORDER DIRECTING BRIEFING ON MOTION**


