**DECLARATION OF RAMSEY M. AL-SALAM IN SUPPORT OF
GOOGLE INC.'S REPLY TO ITS MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

I, Ramsey M. Al-Salam, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am a partner with Perkins Coie LLP, counsel for defendant Google Inc. (“Google”) in the above-identified action. I am submitting this declaration to authenticate the evidence in support of Google’s reply to its motion for summary judgment.

2. Rose Anne Hagan appeared as a witness for Google under Rule 30(b)(6) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. She testified on various topics, including the time that products have been sold through the “Google Store.” She testified that products have been sold through the Google Store since at least 2001. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a copy of pages 54-55 from her October 21, 2008 deposition transcript.

3. The testimony and documents Google has produced reflect that its co-branding agreement with Dorling Kindersley Ltd. (“DK”) relating to reference books began in 2003.


