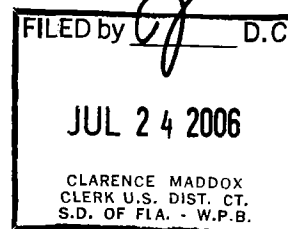

ORDERED that:


1. Defendant's motion is hereby **GRANTED**.
