- 8.) Any notifications to appellant can be forwarded to the above address. Appellant will act promptly to any orders.
- 9.) Appellant desired to retain counselor and investigators. If new trial is warranted, he can better assist in the preparation and investigation of witnesses and gathering of facts to establish his immocence.

WHEREFORE, for the above stated reasons, appellant would ask this Honorable Court to issue an order granting him his immediate release pending review of appeal.
