**ORDER REJECTING AS MOOT
RECOMMENDATION OF UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

The matter before me is the **Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge and Order** [#133]¹ filed January 20, 2011. The magistrate judge granted **Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Stay of Pretrial Deadlines Pending Decision on Unopposed Motion for Transfer of Venue** [#131] filed January 19, 2011, and recommended that the Trial Preparation Conference and trial be vacated. By separate order, I have granted plaintiffs' unopposed motion seeking to transfer venue and have vacated these matters. (**See Order Granting Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Transfer of Venue** [#148] filed February 23, 2011.) The recommendation, therefore, is moot.
